Review chapter 1.

- Does God still speak? How does He speak? What does He say?
- A righteous fit. These are OK to have now and again.
- God's answer; not what Habakkuk had in mind.
- Tries to point out the flaw in God's plan.
- Will God use "the enemy" to correct you? Absolutely. Bummer.

Ended at 2:1. This is probably where Habakkuk was and what he was doing when he had the vision.

- Know nothing about him outside of this book.
- If he was a soldier and this was his job, just another reminder that God can use anyone anywhere.

Nowhere does God refer to his own people as righteous in all of this. That's the point. The Chaldeans are a judgment. [3] Judges shuffle.

2:4-5

- [3] Romans 1:17, Galatians 3:11, Hebrews 10:38.
- Who is the proud? The Chaldeans. Refers to them as an individual, but speaking of the people/king.

2:6-8 [4] Back to the chapter

2:9-11 House (capitol, kingdom)

2:12-14 Town (region)

2:15-17 Neighbor (neighboring nations). Compare how people see kingdoms vs how God does from [5] Daniel 2 and 7.

2:18-20 Idols vs. the Lord
