The context of names being given.

- Reaction to special events. In anticipation of special events
- For a desired characteristic, or a reaction to a negative one.

Genesis 5 thing **[3]**

Who gives the name, or new name? Always someone greater.

New names in the OT.

- Abraham, Jacob, Daniel (failed change).
- New name means new identity, new allegiance.

Moses meets God

Exodus 20 and commandment about God's name.

**Is. 7:14, 9:6**

Name of the Father - **John 5:43, 10:25**

Name of the Lord

- **Matt 23:39** Triumphal entry
- **Matt 24:5** False Messiahs
